



QIANXINAN AFFORESTATION PROJECT IN GUIZHOU

Located in the river basin of the Pearl River, this project stretches across five counties in Qianxinan province, southwest China, where the barren landscape is vulnerable to erosion. By establishing native China Fir and Cypress trees in a region previously devoid of natural forest growth, the project is helping to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to mitigate the impact of climate change. Overseen by local forestry bureaus, the project also generates income and job opportunities for local communities by providing them with training in forest planting and management.
