



XIGUAN AFFORESTATION PROJECT IN GUIZHOU PROVINCE

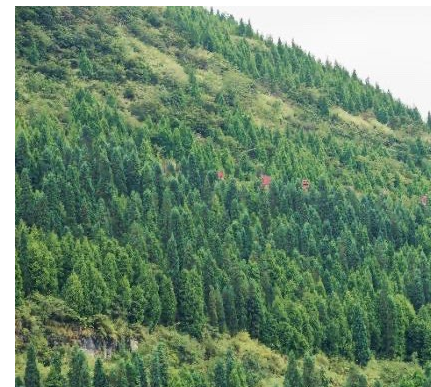

As well as contributing to local sustainable development, establishing forests will also enhance biodiversity and prevent the release of greenhouse gases.
