### ABOUT THIS PROJECT

This project aims to protect and promote the biodiversity of plants and animals as well as to create a habitat for new species, with a focus on planting over 5,000 hectares of teak in the Darién Region in Panamá. Well known for their strength, durability, and weather resistance, teak plantations are established in degraded grassland and act as carbon sinks while improving soil quality. This leads to the prevention of erosion processes and developments in local agricultural activities.

In addition, plantation management will be carried out on a rotational basis, providing long-term, stable, and quality jobs for local community members ensuring fair wages and improving living standards in the project area vicinity. Furthermore, while promoting sustainable management and use of teak forests, the project is building up trained human resources, implementing joined research programs, and generating and sharing new information and knowledge.
